Happy Classroom started its journey formally on 26th January, 2021 under Friends Of Kolkata's Elderly (FOKE). The education programme was in existence since the beginning of the two homes, but when Mrs. Piyali Sen –A retired teacher of D.A.V.Public School decided to dedicate all her spare time in managing and overseeing this programme, it was a wonderful blessing. The passion to carry on with what Mrs. Sen loves most and is well equipped with, FOKE took the opportunity to humbly receive her teaching skills and time she so generously offered. The main area of FOKE's work can be understood from the name itself. We run two free old age homes for destitute elderly people for last 20 years. Apart from caring presently for the 32 elderly residents FOKE is reaching out in caring for the needy elderly in their own habitat by networking with different like –minded local groups.

Our two homes are community centres where Happy Classroom operates for the under previlaged children of the local areas. Happy Classroom is a free learning centre for underprivileged students. We try to provide opportunities to these school-going students to develop their inner interests and skills. Our aim is to help the students to gain knowledge for livelihood, as well as to have self respect, fellow feeling, responsibility towards family, society and environment. We follow West Bengal Board Curriculum as our students attend government schools. Along with academics our curriculum includes art, music, dance, elocution and computer application.

Home visits:

Home visits are a part of our regular activity to have proper coordination between parents and teachers. Teachers of Madhubati Happy Classroom, a place of high dropouts, visit homes of some of the students to enquire about the reasons of frequent absenteeism. Teachers of Thakurpukur Happy Classroom also made home visits of a few students for similar reasons.



Parent Teacher Meetings

First Parent Teacher Meeting of the academic year 2024 was held on 2nd January. The morning session for the primary students started on the same day at Madhubati village H.C Next Parent Teacher Meeting was held on 24th May at Thakurpukur H.C and again on 27th May at Madhubati village H.C to inform the parents about their ward's progress.



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An interactive session on pedagogy was held on 13th of April by Ms. Piyali Sen. It was attended by all the teachers of our two centres. Teachers discussed the challenges that they face in their day to day teaching process and gave suggestions to each other to overcome them. The Monthly Review Meetings are also conducted by Ms. Sen to discuss about academics, teaching learning materials, mental health of the students and other issues related to pedagogy.

We are happy to inform you that two of our students have successfully completed their Assistant Nursing Course conducted by the Rotary Club and the St John Ambulance. Now they are persuing Higher Secondary course.

Manisha Mondol, another student, got financial support from us for six months Basic Computer Course and her Higher Secondary education.
